Mona was named Rotarian of the Year n 1995-96 and again in 1997-98 for the San Juan Rotary Club. She was named Rotarian of the Year for District 7000 in 1998-99. In 1999-2000, she was recognized for her Meritorious Services to the District. She served as Assistant Governor in 2000 - 2001, and in 2002 - 2003 she was elected Governor of District 7000, which has 36 clubs. During her governorship she stressed environmental projects and annual contributions to the Rotary Foundation. She is a Multiple Paul Harris Member, a Sustaining Paul Harris Member and a Rotary Benefactor.

Before leaving Puerto Rico in 2007, she chaired the Matching Grants and Paul Harris Contributions Committees for her district .

As Mona starts her new life here in Sarasota, we welcome her to our club and look forward to her involvement.

The three ladies named above have a lot in common, they are all powerful, they have had an incredible impact on our world, and they all graduated from Wellesley College. However, only one has the distinct honor of calling themselves a member of the Sarasota Keys Rotary Club. That privilege has been reserved for *Mona Gordon!*

At Wellesley college, **2** Mona obtained a BA in History with a minor in Music. She married right out of college and lived in Puerto Rico for more than 40 years. **2** She is the proud mother of 3 sons who have given her 4 granddaughters and 2 grandsons. **3**

In 1964 she founded the League of Women Voters of Puerto Rico and was president of the San Juan League. Later, she went on to **4**

In 1971 she established her company, *Escrutinio Legisiativo, Inc.* (Legislative Scrutiny, Inc). Daily her company was responsible for reporting the actions of the Legislature and the three Executive Branches of the government to her clients. After selling her business in 1996 she became a legislative consultant, specializing in optimizing relations between her clients, the government and their communities.

Mona, a true trail blazer, became a Rotarian in 1987, (*at that time the San Juan Rotary Club was just starting to accept women*). She was elected the first woman president of the Club in the Rotary year 1998-99. During her incumbency the Club sponsored a poster contest with the theme: Puerto Rico: Your Cleanliness is Your Beauty. The winning poster

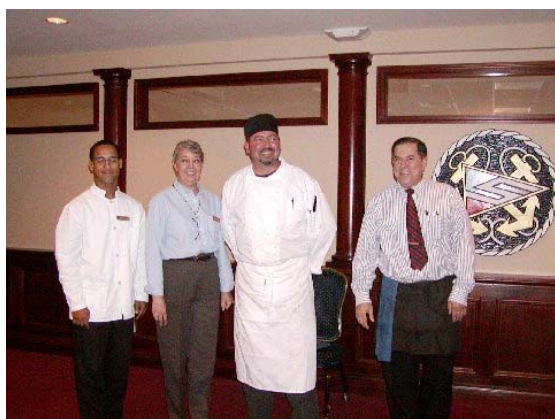
