On last week we had the opportunity to hear from a representative of Children First, a non-profit organization that annually serves over 500 of Sarasota County's most vulnerable children and their families. Their goal is to provide children with what all children deserve - *a safe place to learn, nutritious meals, and a nurturing environment with individualized attention.* As an organization, they focus on the children and families in our community who are at risk because of poverty.

They target all of the key areas necessary to give children a healthy start. Children First address the nutritional, medical, educational, emotional and developmental needs of children from prenatal to five years of age. Their objective is to equip them with all of the skills necessary for a great start in life.

As an organization, Children First has been recognized nationally as a "Program of Excellence." It has been selected as one of the top 40 Outstanding Head Start programs in the United States. In addition to working with the children, they offer support services to the entire family with the aim of helping them establish and achieve their goals.

One of the most popular courses that Children First offers is designed to teach dad

how to be a dad. The nurturing Dad's Initiative shows men how to be fathers to their children. With so many people growing up in single parent homes, men have not had good role models to show them what fathers do. Through this program men are taught how to interact with their children. To date they have successfully trained over 1190 men. This is just one of the many services that Children First offers to our community. They are indeed placing children first.

For those Club members who did not hear the announcement made by Club Secretary, Lee Waters, at our July 9th, 2009 luncheon, the following important financial changes have been enacted by your Board for the duration of this fiscal year. Please note that these changes have been made to help improve our club's financial stability. These changes do not cause an increase in your out-of-pocket expenses paid during your quarterly billing cycles.

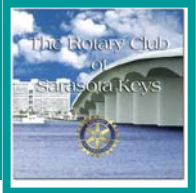
The three proposals unanimously passed by the Board were:

a. Proposal 1: To adjust our members' quarterly dues for the 2009/2010 fiscal year by increasing them from \$40 to \$90, but also eliminating the members' \$50 quarterly Foundation contribution, so that the net cost remains the same for our members.

b. Proposal 2: To eliminate the cost of funding a representative's attendance at the upcoming year's Rotary International Convention.

c. Proposal 3: To keep the Happy Dollars' surplus collected during our luncheon meetings discretionary as determined by the Club's Board of Directors as to either keeping them within our Club's assets or depositing them into our Foundation's.
