Africa is a vast continent that is rich in its resources and beauty. It has long been referred to as the home of the Big Five. Africa's greatest wild animals. The lion, leopard, elephant, buffalo and rhino. But Africa is home to more than just the big five, it is home to millions. It is a continent that is fraught with some very curious paradoxes: *Wealthy resources but extreme poverty; it's the place where exotic plants and animals thrive, but so does extreme hunger and famine; Beautiful rivers, lakes and oceans but contaminated water supplies.*

While animals thrive human beings are rapidly dying from HIV, poverty

and poor medical conditions. Such is the plight of many in Gulu, Uganda. But as bleak as it may seem, it is their ability to triumph over their daily struggles that reveal the inner strength, the true beauty and the strong sense of survival that these people possess. It is easy to thrive when there is no opposition. But when you can stand and survive in spite of it all — *you are the true hero.*

The people of Gulu, Uganda are living breathing super heroes. I count it an honor that I had 10 days to spend with these great people. When you see mothers who while fighting HIV disease struggle to care for 7 children (*often all between the ages of 15 and two months*), get them dressed and off to school, and with meager resources find the ability to pay school fees, prepare meals, and keep a roof over their head and do it all without complaint, antidepressants or xanax you have just witnessed a miracle. In Gulu, I saw a nation of

walking, breathing miracles, Gulu Uganda is producing some strong people, who with a little assistance will become phenomenal leaders. I saw a nation that has produced people that have the ability to survive in spite of it all. As I worked with a team of Doctors, nurses, pharmacists and technicians. I could not help but realize that we were learning more from them than we could ever give. One of the greatest lessons I learned — *we have no right to complain.* I witnessed people with less than we have doing more than some will ever do and doing it with joy. I saw children find hope, overcome tragedies and traumas, the loss of parents, and still dream of success. I saw people who have lost everything due to war and poor conditions rebuilding their lives, learning new occupations and being educated on how to start over. The people of Uganda are strong and rich in spirit and will survive and thrive to rebuild their nation.

has changed their meeting date this week to Thursday so I will not be able to report their activities, But *George Massoud* will cover the meeting and we will report goings on at the next meeting.

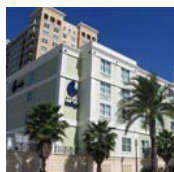

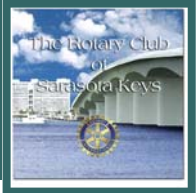
