Mary Ann Spencer is an attorney with the law firm of Schofield and Spencer. She spoke on Guardianship and possible alternatives that are available to insure that your final wishes are carried out. Without a doubt, we are living longer, and with the gift of longevity, comes the responsibility to exhibit sound judgment when it comes to all of our affairs. For some this may prove to be a very simple task for others they may require some type of assistance. Hence, it is

important to know what your options are. Guardianship is needed for individuals who are disabled, and for those whose mental faculties have been compromised due to accident, injury or old age.

One case in point, a widow died with a \$186 million estate. She left \$20 million to her son. He went to court to sue for more. A guardian should have been appointed to insure that her wishes were carried out in regards to the rest of her estate. Of course, we all remember the Schievo case that lingered on for years. Without a written document that clearly spelled out her intentions, it fell to the court to determine who had the right to act on her behalf.

The Michael Jackson case is another example of the need to have your wishes put into writing. Everything was spelled out, the guardian

for his children would be his mother and all of the children's needs were provided for.

Guardianship is something that is not reserved just for the rich and the famous. It is something that each of us should take time to prepare. Every one should have a will, and have documents that delineate your wishes and it should include trust fund plans if you have minor children.

There are several type of guardianships, one could be appointed to take care of your finances and to manage your assets. One could be appointed to make healthcare decisions.

It is important to execute a living will and do not resuscitate orders so that you wishes will be carried out. All declarations should be done in writing with the oversight of an attorney,

The **Interact club** at their meeting last week, decided on their first project. They will become involved in the **Breast Cancer walk**

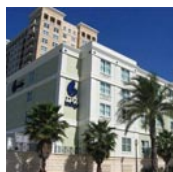
at the end of October. They have also volunteered to for the clean up after words. There were 28 members in attendance.

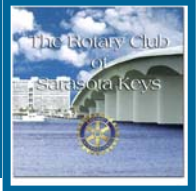
